Applications in Standard Form of Application as published in the Assam Gazette Part-IX are invited from interested candidates who are bonafide citizen of India vide Article 5 to 8 of the Constitution of India for filling up of following vacant posts under the establishment of the Inspectorate of Electricity, Assam.

### Eligibility, requisites, procedure, terms & conditions etc.:

- (A) Candidates must be Citizen of India within meaning of Article 5 to 8 of the Constitution of India.
- (B) Candidates must not be of age less than 18 years and more than 43 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019. However the upper age limit is relaxable in case of SC, ST & other candidates as per Govt. OM No. ABP 06/2016/04. Dtd. 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2016.
- (C) Candidates applying for the above post must possess the prescribed minimum qualification mentioned above.
- (D) The period from the granting of the Driving Licenses should be a minimum of 5(five) years at the time of applying the posts.
- (E) Candidates, who are already employed, should submit their application through proper channel.
- (F) Candidates will have to appear for written test/driving test at their own expenses if and when called for.
- (G) The candidates qualifying in the written test shall be called for Driving skill test and original documents verification process. For every position, candidates shall be called for Driving skill test and original documents verification process in the ratio of 1:4 in order of merit as per the written test marks. The candidates will have to bring their original testimonials for verification alongwith a set of self-attached photo copies of testimonials and to be produced at the time of Driving skill test.
- (H) Incomplete and wrongly filled application form will be summarily rejected and no appeal and/or correction in that regard shall be entertained.
- (I) The envelope containing the application should be clearly marked as "Application for the post of Driver".
- (J) The applications are to be submitted with the following requisites attached thereto:
  - (a) One self-addressed envelope of 5 Cm X 11 Cm affixing unused postal stamp of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five Only).
  - (b) Attested copies of all certificates in support of Educational Qualification, Proof of age and Caste Certificate.
  - (c) Attested copy of valid Professional Driving License for LMV.
  - (d) 2(two) copies of recent passport photographs signed with date by the candidate on reverse side of those.
  - (e) Attested copy of valid Registration Certificates of Employment Exchange.
- (K) Pension Scheme: "Government servants joining the service of the State Govt. on or after 1<sup>st</sup> Feb./05 shall not be governed by the existing Assam Services (Pension) Rules, 1969 and orders issued there under from time to time. So far as their pension and other retirement benefits are concerned, they will be governed by a new set of Pension Rules formulated in line with the Contributory Pension Scheme announced by the Govt. of India vide Finance Deptt. Circular No. BW3/2003-pt.-1/1, Dtd. 25<sup>th</sup> January/05".
- (L) Any postal delay in the process of this matter shall not be a matter of responsibility of the undersigned.
- (M) Canvassing directly or indirectly will be deemed to be appropriate ground for disqualification of the candidature.
- (N) The undersigned reserves the right to accept, modify or cancel the advertisement and to cancel or postpone written test/interview without assigning any reason thereof.
- (O) Candidates should note that authorities may subsequently prepare a short list from the applicants by fixing of cut off level and only those candidates who would qualify to enter the short list may be called for written test.
- (P) Last date of submission of application to the undersigned is **25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 during office hours**.
- (Q) The applications are to be submitted to the undersigned on or before the last date of submission of application. Application received after the last date of submission of application will not be entertained.
